

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Behaviour

The Hope Valley Bowling & Community Club has a "Code of Conduct Policy" to be complied with by Members and Visitors. All members and visitors are expected to conduct themselves in a polite and sporting like manner whilst on the club's premises. Any person behaving in an abusive, threatening or disruptive manner may be asked to leave.

Smoking

Is only permitted within the Club's 2 designated areas. These areas are clearly identified by red bins and are located on the southern end of the carpark next to the emergency exit gate, and the western side of A green next to the storage shed.

Greens

Our Club "Care of Greens Policy" must be observed at all times.

Please do not sit on the banks of the bowling greens.

Before commencement of play please place your bowls carefully onto the playing surface.

Please do not throw the bowling mats. Mats to be placed on the bank between ends.

Dumping of bowls is NOT permitted onto the bowling greens.

If any bowl is delivered in a manner or dropped onto the green from a level considered to be causing damage this will be deemed "Dumping of your bowls".

Bowlers will be requested to alter their delivery action to eliminate dumping. If this cannot be achieved, then the bowlers will be required to use a greens protection mat for the duration of the game.

Failure to do so could result in the immediate removal of the offending bowler.

Footwear

Only approved flat soled bowling shoes or bare feet are to be worn on the bowling greens.

Food & Drink Must **NOT** be consumed on any playing surface.

Bowlers who do not comply with these conditions will NOT be permitted to continue to use our Club's bowling greens.
